Take Charge of Education<sup>®</sup> is a Target school fundraising initiative. It offers families, teachers, and community members an easy way to designate a school of their choice to receive one percent of their purchases made with a Target credit card or a Target check card. In addition, Target donates one-half percent of all Target Visa credit card purchases made everywhere else Visa credit cards are accepted.

All seven of the District's schools are enrolled in the program. Recipient schools can allocate the donated funds for anything they need from books, classroom supplies, field trips, or new technology. The Take Charge of Education dollars are donated to participating schools in September and March. Cardholders and school representatives can visit [Target.com/tcoe](http://Target.com/tcoe), call 1-800-316-6142, or log on to kiosks at Target stores to enroll, or check the status of particular payouts.



Price Chopper is also working with our school community to assist in giving all seven of our schools an opportunity to receive school supplies from the Price Chopper Advantage Card points earned by the purchases of the program's participants. Each of the schools receive a catalog from which they can order school equipment based on the number of points they have received. The catalog include such items as technology equipment, furniture, school supplies, etc.
